1. **Senior Showmanship** – 14 years and older
2. **Junior Showmanship** – 13 years and younger
3. **Mini Jump** – Mini horses 38in and under
4. **Mini Obstacle** - Mini horses 38in and under
5. **Beginner** – (walk/jog/trot) Rider in their 1st or 2nd year showing.
6. **Beginner Command**-(Walk/jog/trot) Judged on the combination of horse & rider.
7. **Beginner Equitation**-(Walk/jog/trot) Judged on equitation and suitability.
8. **Mini Driving**
9. **English Pleasure** – (walk/trot/canter) Judged on pleasure, suitability of horse/rider, and quality of movement.
10. **English Command**-(Walk/trot/canter) Judge on horse and rider combination. Three strides will be allowed of transition.
11. **English Equitation (pattern)** – (walk/trot/canter) Riders judged on equitation and suitability of horse and rider.
12. **Plantation Pleasure** – (walk/easy gait) Judged on pleasure, suitability of horse/rider, and quality of movement.
13. **Plantation Command**- (Walk/easy gait) A horse and rider combination must be performing the gait correctly. Three strides will be allowed of transition.
14. **Plantation Horsemanship (pattern)** - (walk and easy gait) Rider judged on equitation and suitability of horse and rider.
15. **Western Pleasure**-(Walk/jog/lope) Judged on pleasure, suitability of horse & rider, and quality of movement.
16. **Western Command**-(Walk/jog/lope) A horse and rider combination must be performing the gait correctly. Three strides will be allowed of transition.
17. **Western Horsemanship (pattern)** – (walk/jog/lope) Rider judged on horsemanship and suitability of horse and rider.
18. **Cloverleaf Barrels** – timed event
19. **Pick and Stick** - timed event
20. **Pole Bending** – timed event

EVERYONE MUST PARTICIPATE IN SHOWMANSHIP

- All exhibitors that are members of the Tri-County area clubs ages 9-21 in 4-H or FFA are eligible to participate.
- Division awards to be presented at end of show. Ribbons will be awarded to entries in all classes.
- Dress code applies for all classes.
- All 4-H and FFA members competing in the Tri-County 4-H and FFA Horse Show will be required to wear approved protective headgear, including in the ring and on the fairgrounds during the show regardless of age.
- Premier Exhibitor Award will be presented. This will combine 1 Division, skill-a-thon points, and showmanship. You may compete in as many divisions as desired, however only the highest will count towards Premier Exhibitor. One horse per division.
- Skill-a-thon will be available on horse show day for exhibitors to participate.
- Points will be scored as follows: 1st/5, 2nd/4, 3rd/3, 4th/2 and 1 point for each participant.
- Please mail copy of Coggin's with entry.
- Pre-registration is required. See front for deadlines.

4-H Divisions – Most points for each division class will win division. Must enter all 3 division classes to be eligible for awards.
